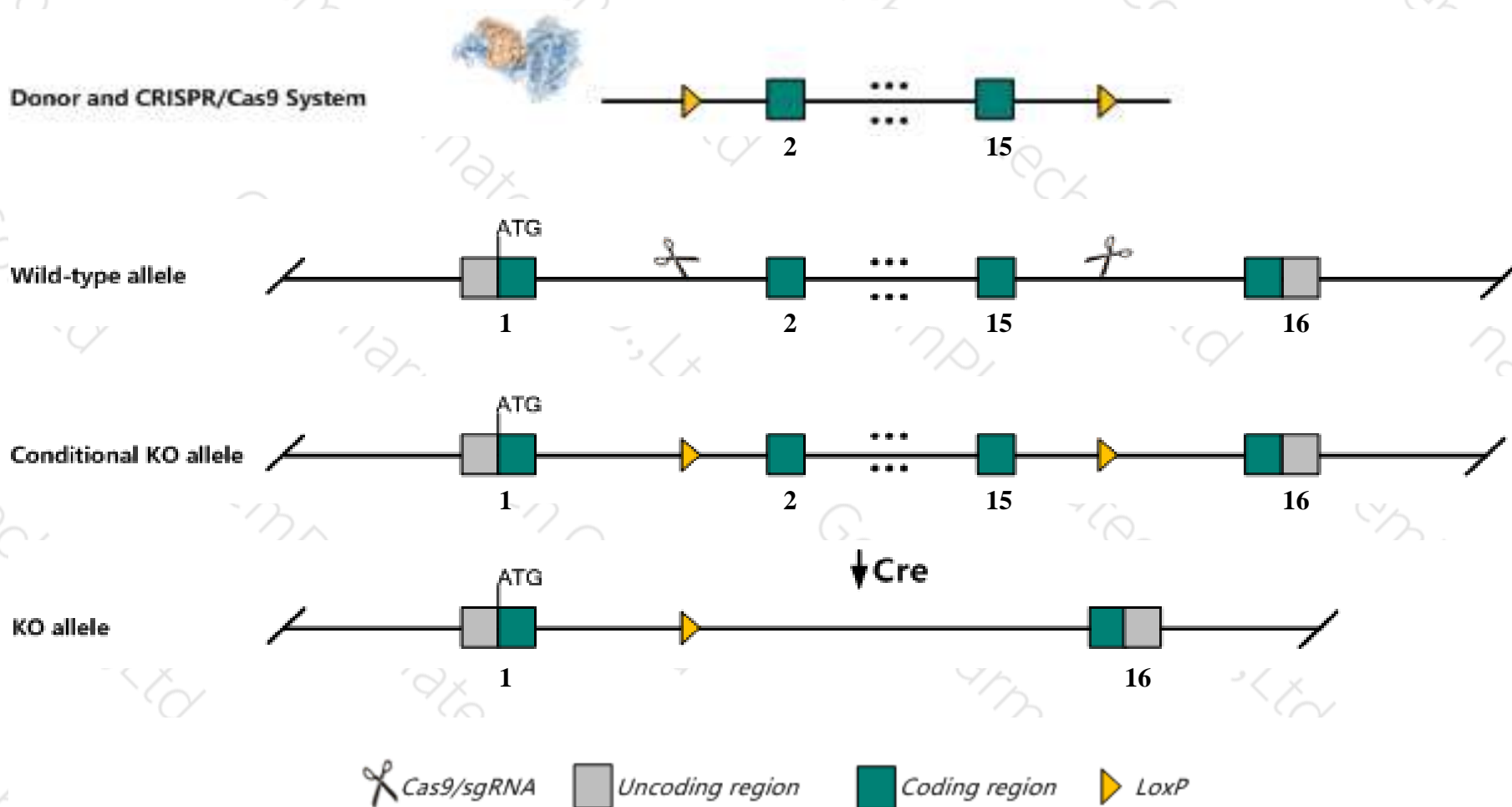

Conditional Knockout strategy

This model will use CRISPR/Cas9 technology to edit the *Il12rb1* gene. The schematic diagram is as follows:



- The *Il12rb1* gene has 6 transcripts. According to the structure of *Il12rb1* gene, exon2-exon15 of *Il12rb1-201* (ENSMUST00000000808.7) transcript is recommended as the knockout region. The region contains 1793bp coding sequence. Knock out the region will result in disruption of protein function.
- In this project we use CRISPR/Cas9 technology to modify *Il12rb1* gene. The brief process is as follows: sgRNA was transcribed in vitro, donor vector was constructed. Cas9, sgRNA and Donor were microinjected into the fertilized eggs of C57BL/6JGpt mice. Fertilized eggs were transplanted to obtain positive F0 mice which were confirmed by PCR and sequencing. A stable F1 generation mouse model was obtained by mating positive F0 generation mice with C57BL/6JGpt mice.
- The flox mice was knocked out after mating with mice expressing Cre recombinase, resulting in the loss of function of the target gene in specific tissues and cell types.

- According to the existing MGI data, Mice homozygous for a knock-out allele exhibit decreased serum IFN-gamma levels in response to recombinant IL-12 or LPS treatment, and failure of ConA-activated splenocytes to proliferate or secrete IFN-gamma in response to IL-12.
- The *Il12rb1* gene is located on the Chr8. If the knockout mice are crossed with other mice strains to obtain double gene positive homozygous mouse offspring, please avoid the two genes on the same chromosome.
- This Strategy is designed based on genetic information in existing databases. Due to the complexity of biological processes, all risk of loxp insertion on gene transcription, RNA splicing and protein translation cannot be predicted at existing technological level.

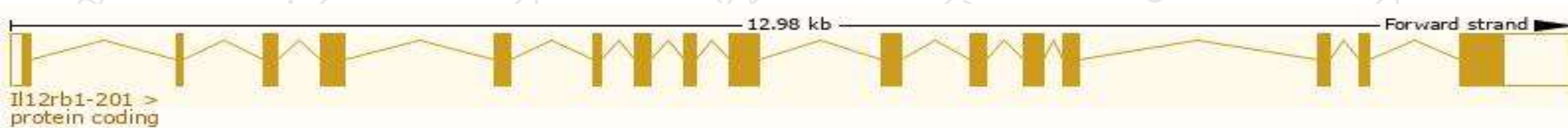

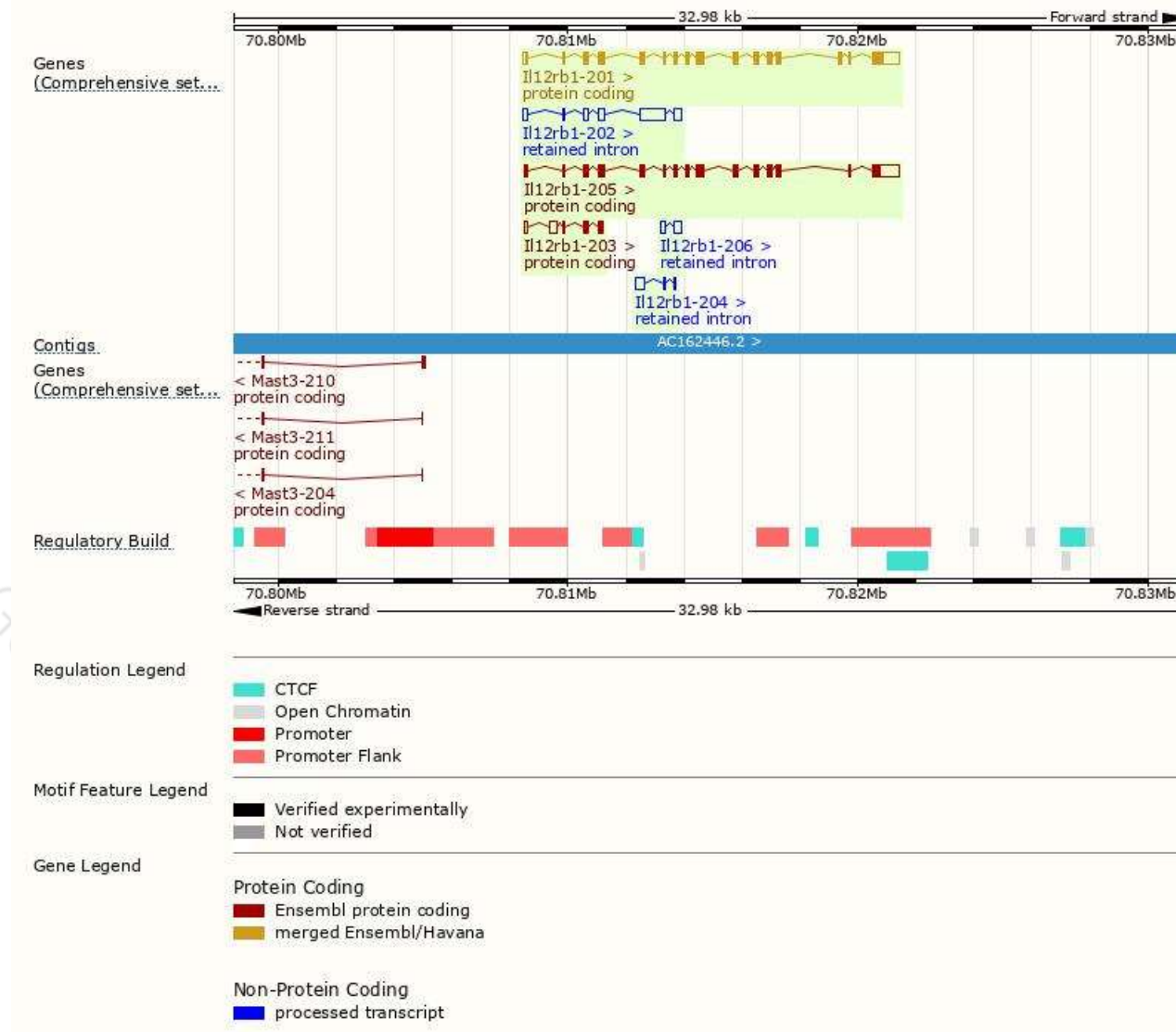

The strategy is based on the design of *II12rb1-201* transcript, The transcription is shown below



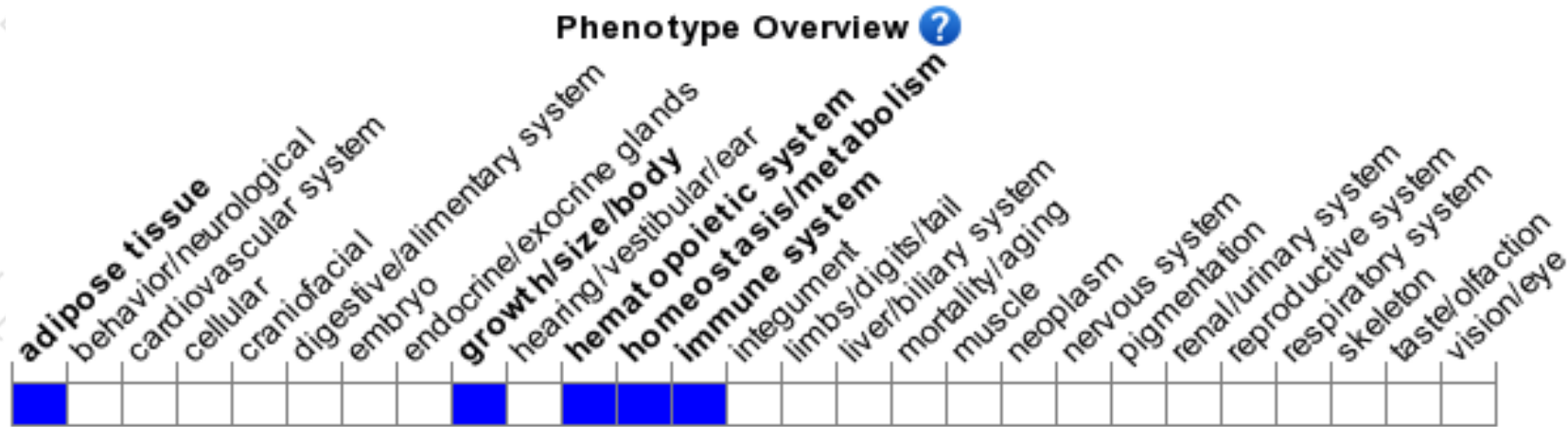
Genomic location distribution
